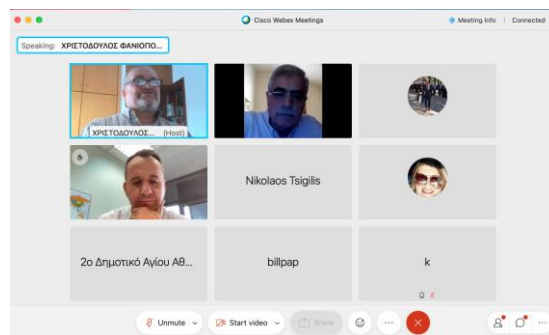
Half-day Informative Conference at the 3rd PEKES Educational District of Pella to present the School-Wide Positive Behavior Support Project in Greece.

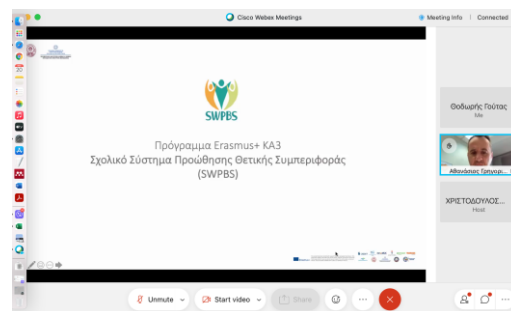

The program of the event included four presentations.

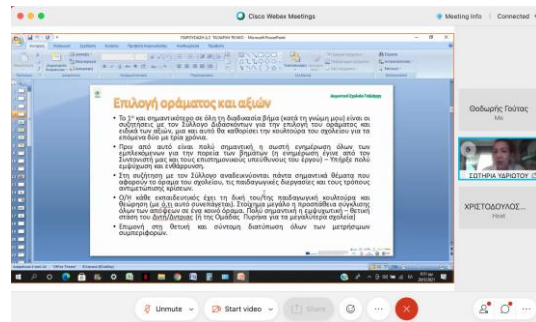

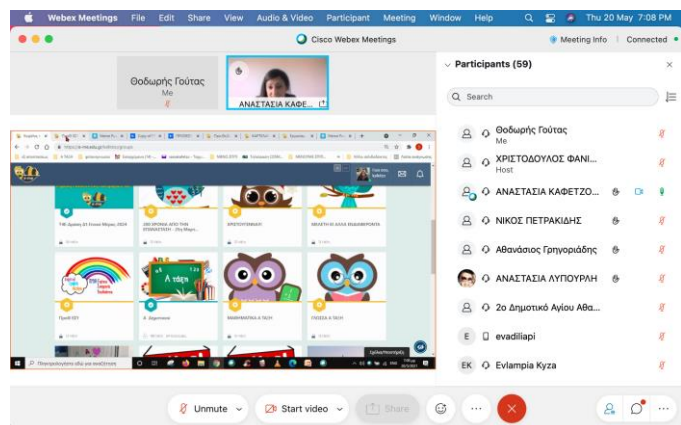
